

CARD TRACKING OPTIONS

Tracking your cards can be as simple as using a writing panel, scanning a barcode or encoding a magnetic strip, below is a brief description of the options available to you.



1. BARCODES

A great way to intergrate a point of sale system

OPTION 01 CODE 39



Requires minimum 4 Digits.
Made up of numbers
and/or letters.

OPTION 02 CODE 128



Requires minimum 4 Digits.
Made up of numbers
and/or letters.

OPTION 03 EAN 13



Requires 12 digits. Made up
of numbers only and will
have a randomly selected
check digit to make
13 digits in total.



2. NUMBERING

Numbering is a great way to keep track of your numbered cards

A. SEQUENTIAL NUMBERING

B. RANDOM NUMBERING



3. WRITING PANEL FOR CODE

This is a special finish printed onto your card that allows you to write information onto the card.



4. MAGNETIC STRIP

Magnetic strip cards work by storing data as a pattern of positive and negative magnetic stripe fields. When the card is read, that pattern is decoded and the information translated into a usable format.
